TASTING NOTE

We harvest the fruit for this wine much later than is typical for most dry styles of Riesling. At this level of ripeness, the fruit expresses a tropical quality rarely found in a dry Riesling. The tropical flavors and bracing acidity give this wine an uncommon brightness and power.

PRODUCER

Boundary Breaks is located on the east side of Seneca Lake in the Finger Lakes AVA of New York. In 2007, owner Bruce Murray purchased a 120-acre farm that had been in the same family since 1850. Murray's goal was to develop a vineyard that could yield Finger Lakes Rieslings and Cabernet Franc wines comparable to those produced in iconic regions around the world.

VINEYARD INFORMATION

The 2022 vintage was very warm and dry, particularly during mid-July through the end of August. Berry size remained small, which resulted in a lighter harvest. The quality of the wines are exceptional, which is good news, but the quantities are limited.
