Song of the Earth

In the Dordogne valley, We, the Cooperative Winegrowers of Périgord, cultivate with passion and respect for Nature the diversity of our terroirs. Here, the grapes ripen with the temperate seasons, soaked in sunshine, in a setting of unspoiled nature. From Bergerac to Monbazillac, each terroir produces typical wines, with distinct notes and styles. We imagined Cantus Terra, the Song of the Earth in Latin, as a hymn to these terroirs.

VINEYARD

The vineyard extends over the best exposed terroirs on limestone or stony soil. The harvest is carried out traditionally.

VINIFICATION

Separate vinification of the grape varieties in self-draining vats, long maceration 2 to 3 weeks. Thermal regulation of fermentation. Aging on lees in contact with French oak wood. Medium heat.

GRAPES VARIETIES

From our best Merlots for fruit and roundness, assembled with Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc for structure and complexity.

TASTING NOTES

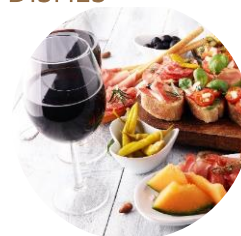
Beautiful purple color. Nose with aromas of red fruits, slightly liquorice. Toasted mouth. Fruity finish. Nice volume.
