WINEYARD

Orange wines are a tradition dating back to antiquity, practiced in the Caucasus. We decided to reinterpret this tradition with grapes from a plot selection, in IGP Atlantique and certified Agriculture Biologique and NOP.

VINIFICATION

Orange wine is a maceration wine, like reds, but with white berries. The grapes are not directly pressed but placed in vats with the skin in order to extract the color and tannins. Pumping over is done during the alcoholic fermentation and devatting before the end. This wine undergoes malolactic fermentation.

GRAPE VARIETIES

Sémillon

TASTING

Yellow color with orange highlights. Very aromatic nose of orange blossom and marmalade with a slight muscat note. The palate is clean, aromatic and complex, with a finish of orange peel, slightly bitter without aggressiveness.


