TERROIR

Clay-limestone soils

IN THE VINEYARD

Harvested by plots and grape varieties selections

VINIFICATION

Filling-in stainless steel or concrete vats with temperature control

Pre-fermenting maceration

From 20 to 30 days maceration

Malolactic fermentation in vats

AGEING

Aged in vats from 12 to 14 months

VARIETALS

Merlot 80%, Cabernet sauvignon 20%

SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

TASTING

A bright, full-bodied wine with floral red berry and plum aromas over a lively and fruit-forward palate.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Enjoy this red while young and fruity with a range of foods from poultry to quiches and pizza or with cheeses.
