Winemaking

Harvested by plots and grape varieties selections
Gravity flow winemaking with temperature control
Pre-fermenting maceration
From 25 to 30 days maceration
Aged in French oak barrels from 12 to 14 months

Tasting Notes

This wine reveals a nice complex nose of red fruits aromas and wooden notes. In the mouth, good tannic structure, roundness and silky smoothness; ripe fruits aromas subtly associated with delicate oaky flavours. A luscious wine with wonderful length.

Serve at room temperature. Pair with roasted or braised meats and strong, semi-mature cheeses.
