- In the north: Côte-Rôtie, Condrieu, Saint-Joseph, Cornas, Hermitage and Crozes-Hermitage. Syrah, the only red variety is sometimes blended with white varieties such as Viognier in Cote-Rotie; Viognier, Marsanne and Roussanne are used to make white wine.
- In the south: Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Gigondas, Vacqueyras, Tavel, Cairanne, Côtes-du-Rhône Villages, Côtes-du-Rhône, Ventoux and Muscat de Beaumes-de-Venise.

Very attached to the region and admiring the diversity and complexity of its different terroirs, Antoine Dupré, General Manager, points out that each wine needs personalised care, adapted to its own evolution and origins, to acquire the character of its appellation and reach a level of excellence.
